



IMPORTANT COMMUNITY NOTICE

We have another positive case of COVID-19 in the community. This is being considered as an outbreak and precautionary measures are being taken immediately.

In an effort to maintain and do our best with exposure we will be **reverting to minimal staffing levels starting Monday, August 10th**. This will be for 2 weeks or until further notice. What does this mean? In-person services will be extremely reduced and we will do our best to provide services either remotely or through the Emergency Operations Center.

This notice reminds us all that this virus is actively spreading. We ask that you continue your personal efforts to minimize the spread and protect your loved ones:

- Stay home as much as possible, limiting your exposure to other households.
- Wear a mask in all public places.
- Continue to practice social distancing.
- Restrict travel to outside of the local area.
- Wash hands frequently or use hand sanitizer.

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
