The Environmental Program within the Natural Resources Department of the Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe has reviewed the plans for increasing the storage capacity of the detention pond and installing a biofilter and down pipe.

Certification

We hereby grant Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe Section 401 Water Quality Certification for this project subject to the following conditions:

1. Ensure discharges from this project will not interfere with the attainment of Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe Water Quality Standards for Surface Waters.
2. Ensure biofiltration system pretreatment chambers are cleaned periodically as needed and media in pre-filter cartridges are replaced periodically as needed.
3. Install and maintain erosion control measures.
4. If there are any substantive changes in the proposed project that may affect water quality, you shall notify the Natural Resources Department of the Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe immediately. Failure to do so will result in revocation of this certificate.
5. You will provide a copy of this certification to all contractors and subcontractors. You shall review the conditions of this certification with all such contractors and subcontractors.
